

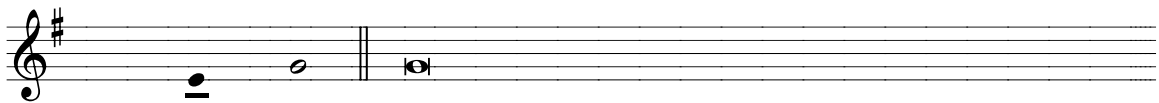
# Palm Sunday (Year B)

The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je- sus Christ according to Mark. ℞. Glory



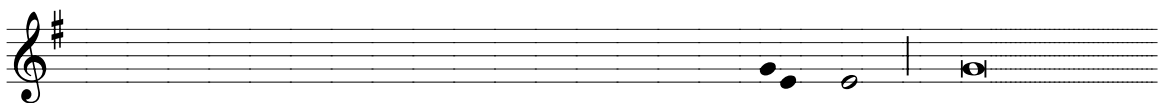
to you, Lord Christ. When they were approaching Jerusalem, at Bethphage



and Bethany, near the Mount of Ol- ives, Jesus sent two of his disciples



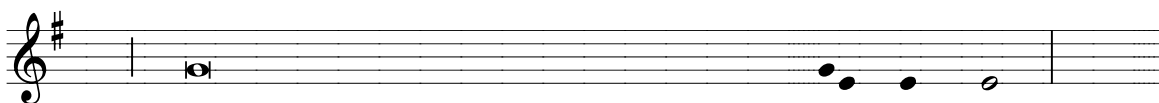
and said to them, “Go into the vil- lage a- head of you, and immediately

As they were un-tying it, some of the bystanders said to them, "What



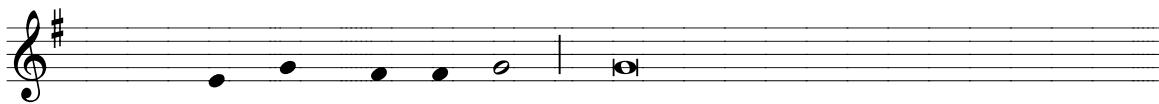
are you doing, un-tying the colt?" They told them what Jesus had



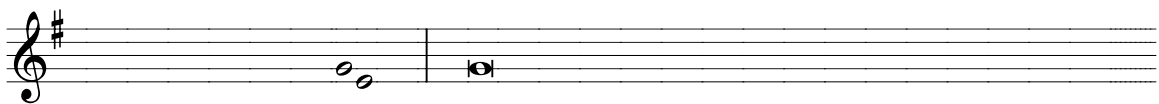
said, and they were allowed to take it. Then they brought the colt to



Jesus and threw their cloaks on it; and he sat on it. Many people



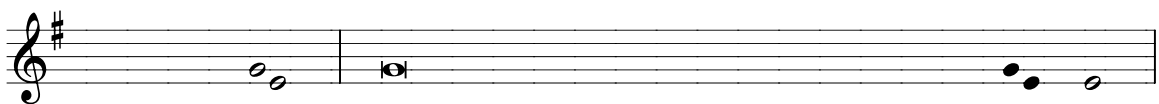
spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that
