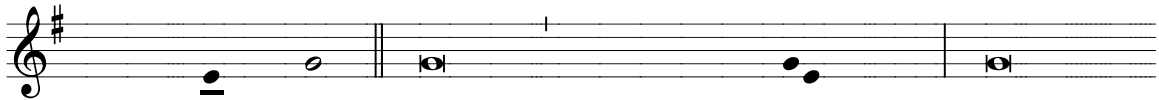


Fourth Sunday of Easter (Year B)

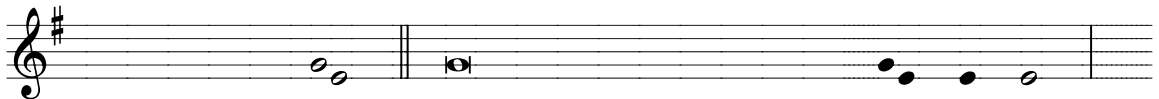
to you, Lord Christ. Jesus said, “I am the good shep-herd. The good



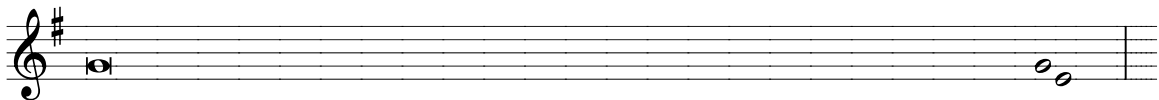
shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand, who is not the
