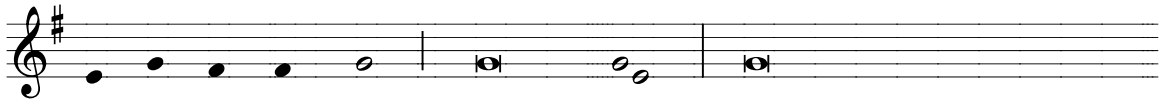
Gospel—John 15: 9-17



The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je- sus Christ according to John. R. Glory to



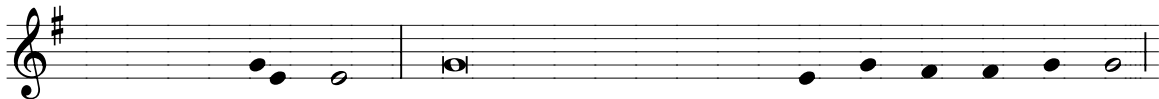
you, Lord Christ. Jesus said to his disciples, “As the Father has loved me,

and abide in his love. I have said this things that my joy may be in you,



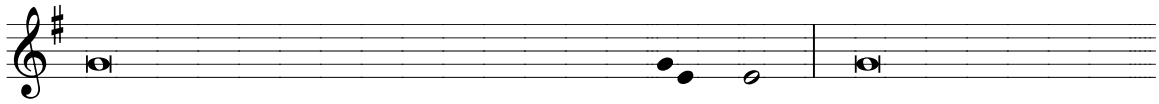
and that your joy may be com-plete. This is my com-mand-ment, that you



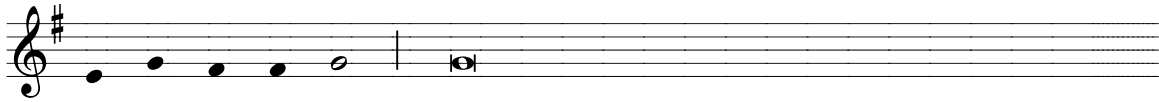
love one another as I has loved you. No one has great-er love than this,



to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.



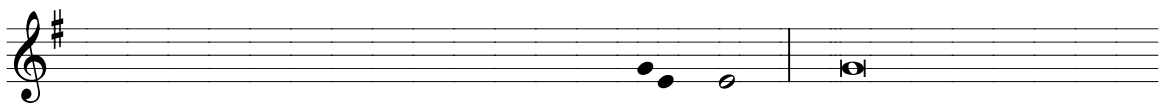
You are my friends if you do what I com-mand you. I do not call you ser-



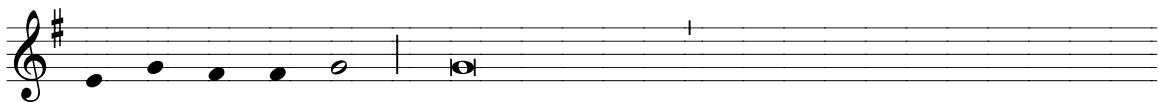
vants a- ny long- er, because the servant does not know what the master is



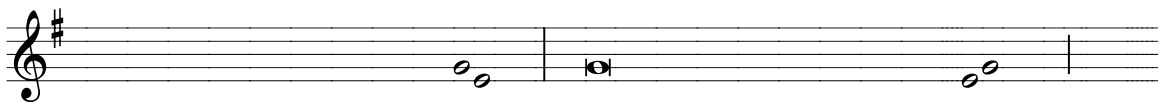
do- ing; but I have called you friends, because I have made known to
