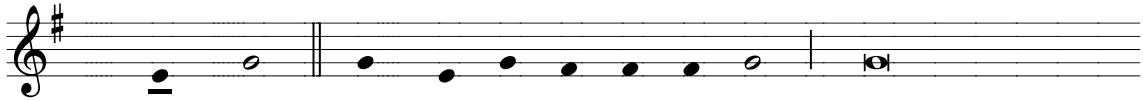

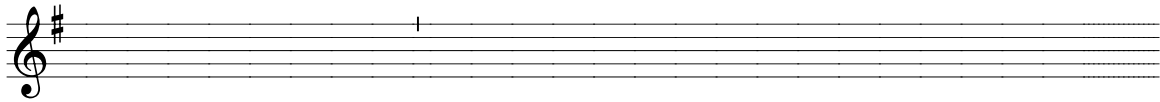

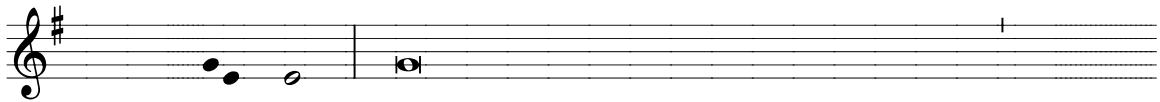
The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je- sus Christ according to Mark. ℞. Glory to



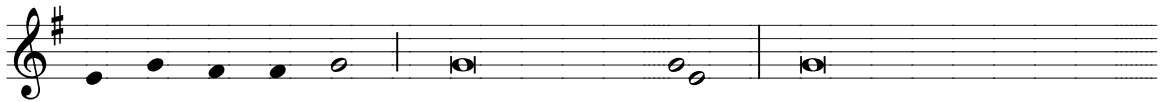
you, Lord Christ. When the sab-bath was o- ver, Mary Magdalene, and



Mary the mother of James, and Salome brought spices, so that they might go



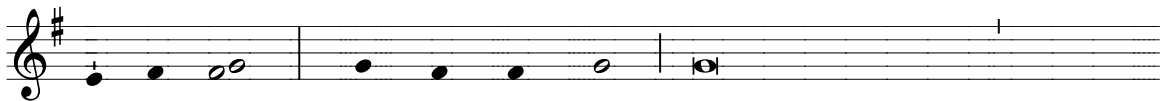
and anoint Je- sus. And very early on the first day of the week, when



the sun had ris- en, they went to the tomb. They had been saying to



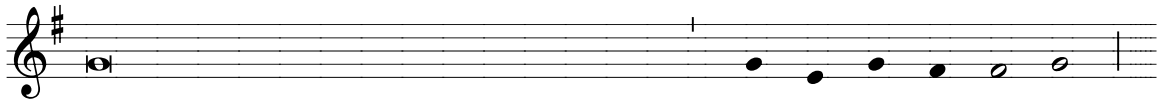
one another, “Who will roll a- way the stone for us from the en- trance



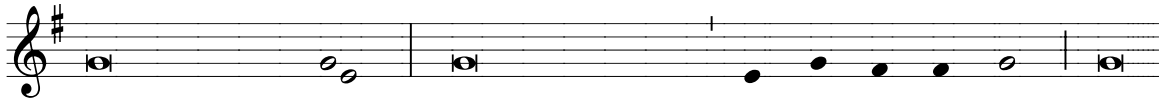
to the tomb?” When they looked up, they saw that the stone, which



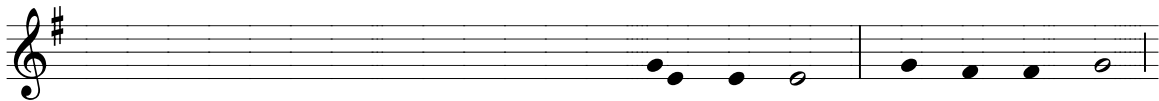
was very large, had already been rolled back. As they entered the tomb,



they saw a young man, dressed in a white robe, sit- ting on the right side;



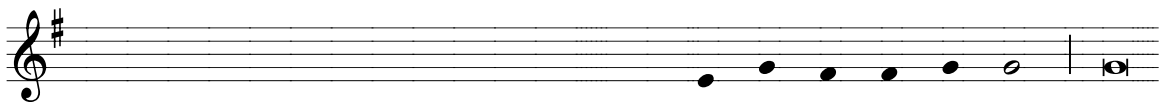
and they were a- larmed. But he said to them, "Do not be a- larmed; you



are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was cru- ci- fied. He has been raised;



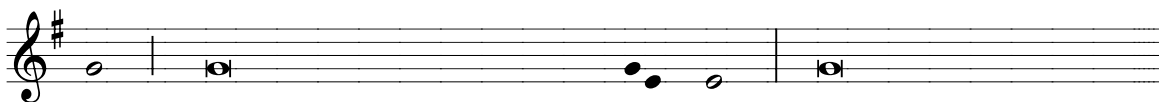
He is not here. Look, there is the place they laid him. But go, tell
