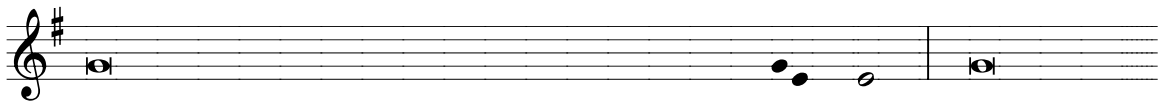
And suddenly there was a great earth-quake; for an angel of the Lord, de-

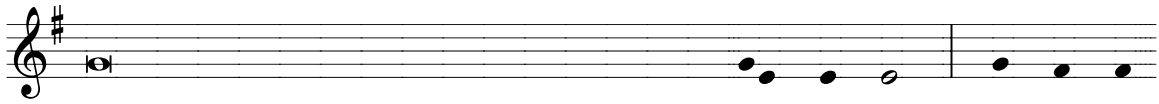
His appear-ance was like light-ning, and his clothing was white as snow.



For fear of him the guards shook and became like dead men. But the angel



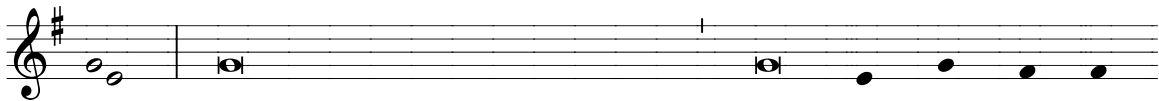
said to the women, “Do not be a- fraid;



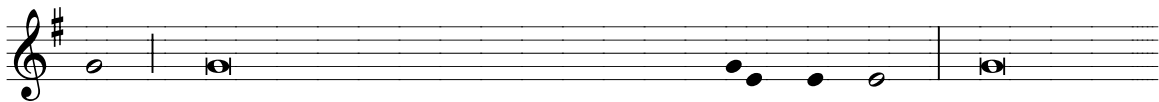
I know that you are looking for Jesus who was cru- ci- fied. He is not



here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where he



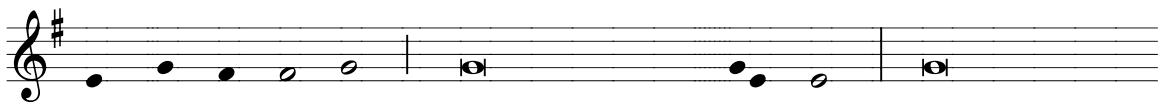
lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples, 'He has been raised from the



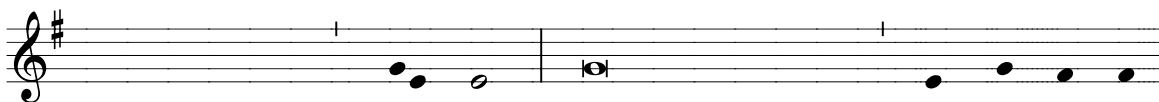
dead, and indeed he is going ahead of you to Gal- i- lee. There you will



see him.' This is my mes- age for you." So they left the tomb quickly



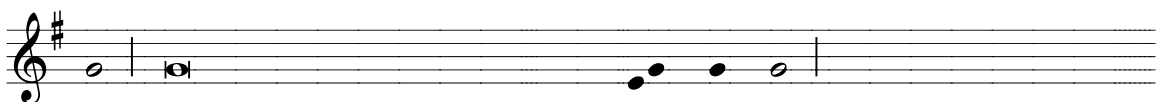
with fear and great joy, and ran to tell his dis- ci- ples. Suddenly Jesus



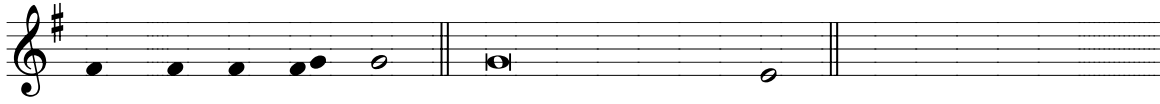
met them and said, "Greet-ings." And they came to him, took hold of his
