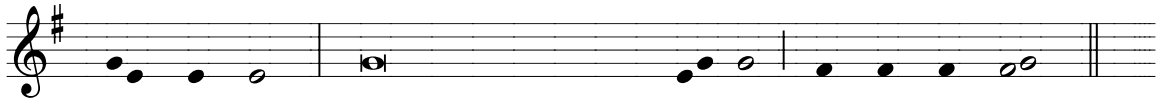
them again, “Peace be with you. As the Fa- ther has sent me, so I send



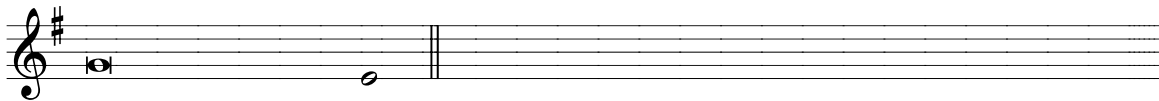
you.” When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them,
