

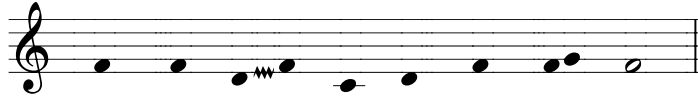

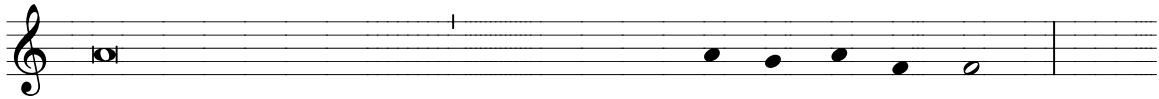

Israel; all you of Ja-cob's line, give glo- ry. 23. For he does not despise

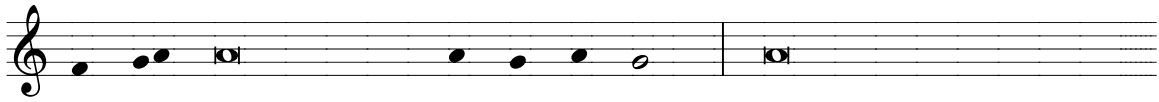


the poor in their poverty; neither does he hide his face from them \*

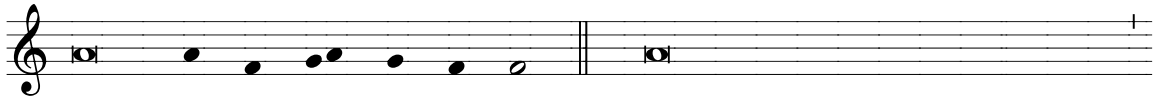


but when they cry to him he hears them.

presence of those who wor-ship him. 25. The poor shall eat and be satisfied

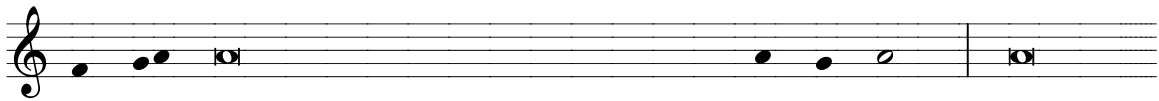


and those who seek the Lord shall praise him; \* "May your heart live

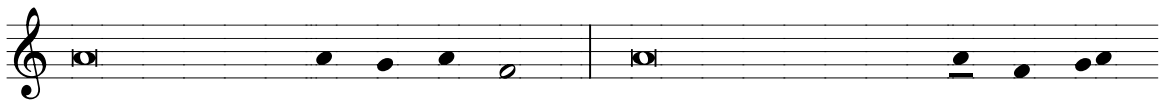
26. All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord, \* and all the

the Lord; \* he rules o- ver the na- tions. 28. To him alone all who sleep

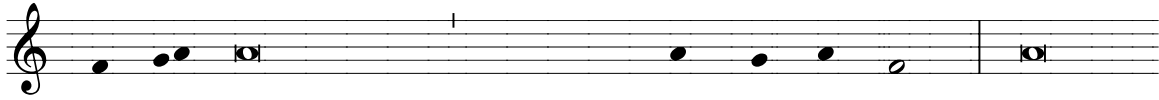


in the earth bow down in wor-ship; \* all who go down to the dust fall be-
