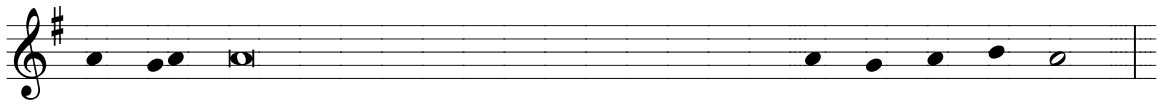

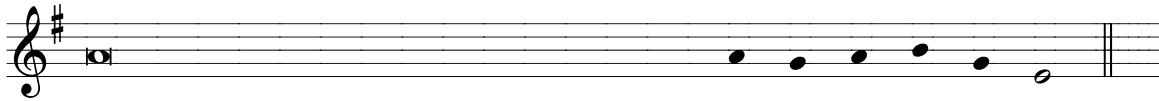


Hap-py are they whose de-light is in the law of the Lord.

nor lingered in the way of sinners, nor sat in the seats of the scorn-ful!

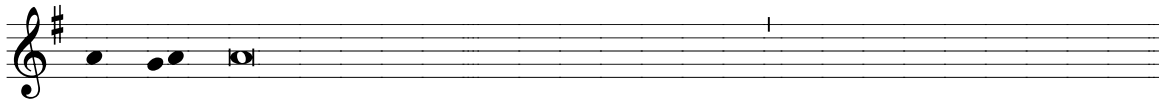


2. Their delight is in the law of the Lord, * and they medi- tate on his l aw
